Old Business:

- 3) Bunkers – Work should be complete September 14th (1,5 and dirt and sod work remain)
- 4) Greens Procedure- Verticut of Greens – Biweekly , Top dressing weekly, rolling and double cutting (one or the other 3 days a week)
- 5) Entry in to short game area – People are parking on #18 cart path (This is incorrect), proper entry is via the parking lot. Jeff will put out emails and continue to add in and post in around club bulletin boards.

- 6) Cart Path Only Holes better signage needed – suggested we put on sign that (By Golf & Greens Committee this hole is cart path only) or something to that verbiage.
- 7) Planned use of old sand from bunker project – Plans are to use the good sand for bunkers on Canyon Creek, and other to top dress fairways on both courses.
