CALL TO ORDER – President Arthur Abelman at 7:07 P.M.

Approval of the Minutes – The minutes were approved as read. Susan made the motion, Rod seconded.

PRESIDENT’S REPORT – Arthur stated that when you accept the responsibility of becoming a member of the Sonterra Tennis Association Board you commit to the obligation of attending the meetings regardless of tennis leagues.
