The Committee meeting was devoted to discussing recent significant violations of The Club's Rules and Regulations, and how to best obtain adherence to the Rules and Regulations.

One violation involved a tennis member's failure to sign in with the pro shop or a marshal, failure to register a guest, and driving a golf cart onto a green. A letter has been sent by Club management to the member, suspending their golf privileges for the remainder of the year. Any future use of the golf privilege would require completion of a golf etiquette class with the golf pro shop.

Another violation involved the smoke free policy of the Club, and the member's verbal abuse of the staff when asked to cease smoking. A letter has been sent by Club management that any future violation of the smoking policy will result in suspension of membership privileges.

The Committee will be encouraging the "Golden Rule" philosophy via newsletters and in Club publications. Members need to do the right thing by following the Club Rules and Regulations that are beneficial to all members. An attitude of "this is my Club and we need to take good care of it" should prevail amongst all members.
