Message From the Board- Julius Germano, Board Chairman

You probably have seen the letter that has been distributed regarding the new program for membership at the Club at Sonterra. As I mentioned in last month's newsletter, we are no exception from the havoc that the toll the economy has taken on the marketing of memberships to country clubs.

There is lot going on right now with golf course maintenance. We are working hard to improve overall playing conditions on both courses, and it is encouraging to see more and more golfers everyday. I would like to take a moment to discuss the greens on both courses. The South Course greens appear to have survived the winter and are transitioning nicely.

We have been using a combination of topdressing, spiking, fertilization, and chemical applications to make this transition as smooth as possible. Putting speeds may slow temporarily (particularly late in the day) as we must allow the grass to begin actively growing before we can get more aggressive with our mowing heights and other cultural practices that provide faster putting surfaces. The North Greens have been putting much better over the last month. Our goal is to keep the overseed around until Mid-June. This will certainly be a challenge, but combination of hand watering, frequent fertility and chemical applications will help keep the grass healthy longer. Another area that we have been working to improve on is bunkers. Several bunkers on both courses have had sand added., the sands will blend with time as Our goal at this point is to achieve consistent sand depth and remove any liners that are affecting play. I have had several questions regarding the type of sand that is being added to the North Course. It is a white sand out of Kosse, Texas called 'Sureplay'. This sand is different than the white sand that has been used here in the past. Sureplay is specifically designed for bunkers is currently being used at many courses around the country. Due to the varying types of sand on the course it is impossible to obtain a consistent color in all the bunkers. However, the obvious color differences will soften substantially with a little time and hopefully a good rain or two. I want to thank all of you for your patience and support as we approach the summer. It is going to be an exciting year and I look forward to discussing the North Greens renovation in next month's newsletter. Thank you for being a member and please don't hesitate to contact me with comments, suggestions, or concerns.

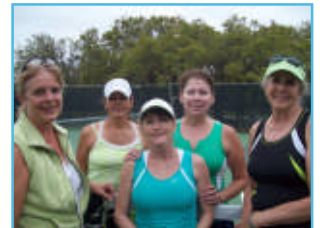
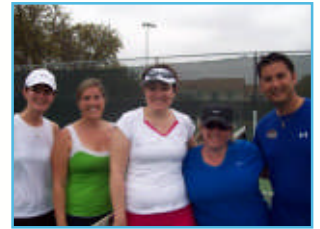

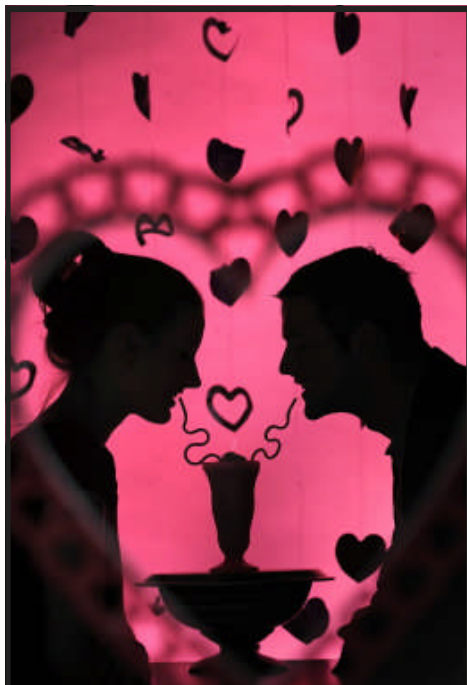
